## Continuing Classes & Workshops

Continuing classes are offered for students who wish to learn more on styles and techniques of bonsai. Classes include lecture/demonstration and, under the guidance of the instructor, are followed by hands-on work on plant material. All Day Workshops are held full or half day, Saturdays or Sundays and Wednesdays for those who are free midweek. Students who need help with maintenance, care and developing bonsai can work on those personal trees or may also start new projects with the advice of the instructor. Students may bring any trees that need help. The Studio has available for purchase material for students to create their own bonsai and bonsai supplies. For All Day Workshops students are recommended to bring their lunch. Fee: \$ 60.00 full day - 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Or \$40.00 half day

*\*For continuing classes and workshops students are required to have taken Introduction to Bonsai Class or equivalent and expected to bring their own supplies  
.Up to 4 qts. of soil will be provided.  
(Basic tools are available for loan.)*
