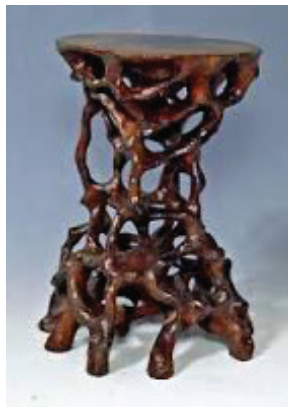

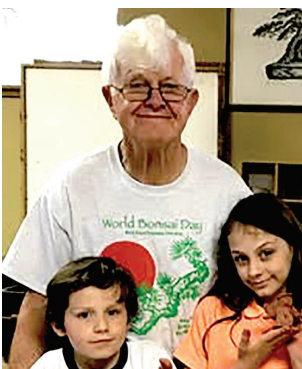

## Chase Spring Tips

Spring is here but still cold at night with a chance of frost till May! we have most evergreens and a few deciduous bonsai outside on benches already being very careful with the new growth.

If it does not freeze again:

- Put the plants on the ground and cover with sheets to keep the frost and cold weather off the plants.

Many deciduous bonsai are still protected, a good tip is:

- Start pinching new growth to keep them in bounds.

Should you miss this spring's growth you can:

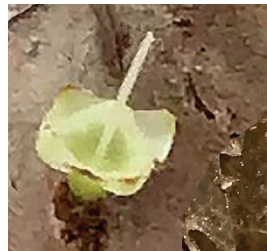
- Cut back and leaf prune in June.

Remember evergreens need full sun at this moment.

- Start fertilizing with both liquid and dry organic fertilizer.
